YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IF YOU:

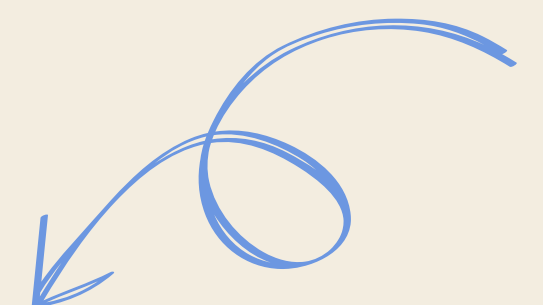
- ☐ Are 18 years of age or older

 - > your partner controlled your money or ability to see family & friends

- ☐ Resided in NM when you experienced one of these forms of violence
- ☐ Are willing to share your thoughts on the services available or needed for those experiencing partner violence
